Today's Readings: Melchizedek, a pagan priest- king, gives gifts of bread and wine to Abraham. In Christian tradition, that bread and wine were taken to anticipate the Eucharist (1st Reading). The Psalm is about Melchizedek as a model for the priesthood of Christ. When we celebrate the Eucharist we do not just make Christ present, but re-enact the death by which he saved us (2nd Reading). Jesus provides an extraordinary meal for those who followed him into the desert. In the Eucharist the Church continues the Mission of Jesus – teaching, healing and nourishing God's People
