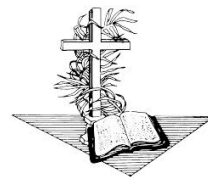

Today's Scripture:



King David recognises his sins, which have shown contempt for God. Yet God will forgive him (1st Reading).

The Blessing of forgiveness is celebrated by one whose fault is removed (Psalm). Paul says that if the law could have saved us there would have been no point in Christ's death upon the cross (2nd Reading). Jesus shows how the greatest sinner, when forgiven by God, can show the greatest love (Gospel).



"Amoris Laetitia" is the name of the recent apostolic exhortation by Pope Francis "On Love in the Family".

It is an extended homily on marriage and family life. It is an optimistic, yet realistic, view of marriage and family life in these times.

It examines a wide variety of issues facing families today, ranging from unwed mothers to lack of housing, from co-habitation to divorce, as well as discussions on the elderly, widows, families with special needs and more.

While upholding the timeless doctrines and teachings of the faith, Pope Francis stresses the importance of tenderness, compassion, and gentle encouragement along the path to conversion.
