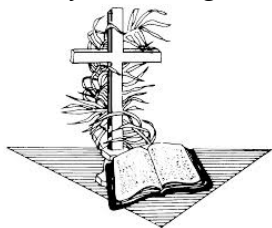

Today's Readings: The First Reading is about the call of Elisha. The cloak symbolises power, and the transfer of power. See how total was the response. Jesus demanded a similar response from those who would follow Him.

The Psalm is a Psalm of Trust: a description of the psalmist's loyal relationship to the Lord alone, and a remarkable statement of the awareness of God's guidance and intimate presence.

In the Second Reading Paul lists some of the things that the call to follow Jesus involves. The Gospel outlines what is involved in full commitment to Jesus; we must place our grudges, personal desires, and even our most sacred worldly obligations aside in order to walk truly and completely with them.

The Pope will reply to some of the questions in a book to be published in the coming months in various languages and countries.

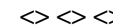
Pope Francis 'On Love in the Family:
