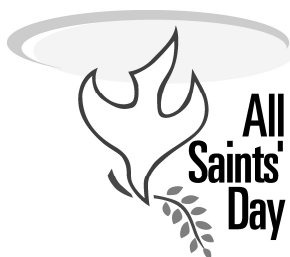

**TODAY'S FEAST:** think of the loved ones who inspired you with their lives and then be conscious of the many people being remembered around the world on this feast of All Saints.

- We remember these people and give thanks for them
- The Kingdom of heaven is a reality and it will come
- Canonisation ceremonies are for a few, but saintliness is for all
- Our Saints are the people who gave us the gift of faith.



Holy Indulgences are about the healing of sins through Prayer, Penance and Holy Eucharist. Practices central to obtaining an indulgence are –

- genuine conversion to Christ
- sincere distance from personal sin
- true repentance for the sins committed and confessed.

To gain an indulgence for the Souls of the Departed – from 12 noon on the **1st November** until **midnight** on the **2nd November**, confess your sins, receive Holy Communion and pray for the Pope's Intentions. Visit a church and recite there one **Our Father**, one **Hail Mary** and the **Apostles' Creed**.
