Today's Readings:



In the 1st Reading we read that God, who created the world out of love, has pity on people in their sins so that they can repent. **In the Psalm**, God is glorified for his mercy and kindness, ‘slow to anger and rich in mercy.’

In the Gospel we see the Lord's compassion towards a sinner – the tax-collector, Zacchaeus. **In the 2nd Reading**, Paul encourages Christians to fulfill their call by the living of the Christian life in perseverance: this is the day-to-day way to glorify God and to be glorified by Him.
