We are delighted to welcome the ICON of the Holy Family to the parish as part of the preparations for the World Meeting of Families. An Icon is a devotional painting of Christ and other holy figures. The icon represents Jesus at the heart of ordinary family life – whether gathered at the table or a wedding party or at a sickbed. Visually it expresses that wherever we are, Jesus is present alongside. It invites us to ponder how we live our family life.

- **The Icon will be in Holy Cross Church from Wednesday next at 4pm until Friday noontime.**
- **Prayer Service will be conducted on the hour each day by various parishes, schools and groups.**
