Trinity Sunday:

TODAY’S READINGS seem to say we need to be adopted children of God, and DO what God commands. What are some practical ways? I have lived out my ‘Trinity’ faith. TODAY’S SCRIPTURE: 1st Reading: Moses reminds the people about God’s deeds, and declares that there is but one God. **Psalm:** Those whom God chooses are blessed by divine kindness and deliverance. **2nd Reading:** We are all God’s children, co-heirs with Christ, filled with the Spirit. **Gospel:** The disciples are given the mission to preach and baptise in the name of the Trinity.
