**1<sup>st</sup> READING:** Moses made an agreement with God on behalf of the people and sealed this covenant in blood. **PSALM:** We take the cup of salvation and trust in the name of God. **2<sup>nd</sup> READING:** The new covenant we celebrate was sealed in the blood of Christ. **THE SEQUENCE** (which is recited after the 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading) is a poetic reflection of the Eucharist. **GOSPEL:** Jesus offers the bread and wine, his Body & Blood, as the new covenant.
