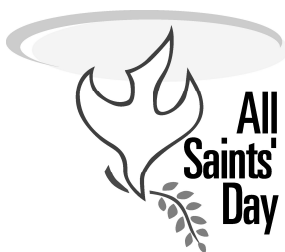

- Our Saints are the people who gave us the gift of faith.



Holy Indulgences are about the healing of sins through Prayer, Penance and Holy Eucharist. We are bound to our deceased loved ones by the witness of faith and love that they have left us. As we remember them in the Eucharist, we can, in the mystery of the Communion of Saints.

Pray for them, that our merciful Father may free them of every fault and embrace them in endless happiness.

To gain an indulgence for the Souls of the Departed – from 12 noon on the **1st November** until **midnight** on the **2nd November**, confess your sins, receive Holy Communion and pray for the Pope's Intentions. Visit a church and recite there one **Our Father**, one **Hail Mary** and the **Apostles' Creed**.
