## Today's Scripture Readings:



1<sup>st</sup> Reading: This is part of a vision of the prophet Daniel about the end of time. It introduces the belief in a resurrection of the dead; that God will save his chosen people, since He has the power even to raise us from the dead.

**Psalm**: The path to life and fullness of joy is the inheritance of the faithful. **2nd Reading:** The reading insists on the superiority of Christ's sacrifice: God's power to forgive sins and restore his people to life comes to us through the one

supreme sacrifice of Christ on the Cross. Through faith in Christ we are freed from sin and death. **Gospel:** Jesus teaches his disciples not to worry about when he will return in glory. Even though terrible disasters must happen first, Christ is near, his word is true, and he will gather his people to himself.

# Second World Day of the Poor 18th November.

Pope Francis established this day as 'a way to prepare for the Feast of Christ the King' (*next Sunday*) who identified with the little ones and the poor and who will judge us on our works of mercy.'

The 2018 message of Pope Francis is available on-line. The theme this year is "*This poor man cried, and the Lord heard him.*" Psalm 34.

This day invites us to be mindful of poverty locally and globally, of homes and families locally where there is poverty, to honour the work of the St. Vincent de Paul and those who contribute to their collections.
